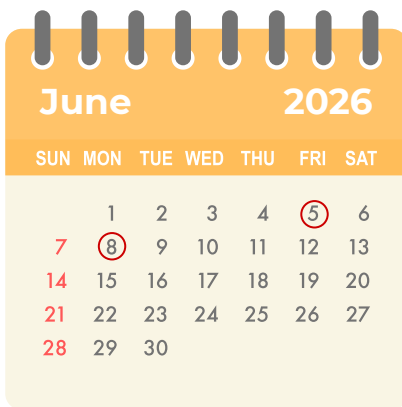




What kind of critters are decomposers in soil?
